# FRANK COLYER **EX-PROFESSOR** DIES RECENTLY

Funeral services were held at the First Presbyterian church of Carbondele last Sunday afternoon at 2:30, for Mr. Frank M. Colyer, of 784 South University avenue, formerly a professor of Geography at Southern Illinois Normal Uni-versity,

# CARBONDALE, ILLINOIS, FRIDAY, DECEMBER 8, 1944 HAVE WE FORGOTTEN DEC. 7?

Just three years ago today, December 8, 1941 a capacity audience listened to President Roosevelt declare war, im-mediately following the sneak attack on Pearl Harbor. That audience filled the seats in the Shryock Auditorium, because they were the students of Southern Illinois Nor-Inal University. Sober faces, startled eyes, and silence filled a building, unable at that time to house the near 2300 students enrolled in the college. Many lined the walls, while others filled extra chairs set up for the chapel exercises.

Groups rushed to their country's call, others, desiring their degrees, waited for the draft. But few expected the honor roll in the foyer to read over 2000 three years hence. Today a ghostly echo sounds around the Auditorium.

Southern Illinois Normal University has again proven that she is up to standards in the line of registration. Registration this term is not as great as that of last term, but it is much higher than it was this time last year.

Last term 908 students were registered, this term 769 registrations have already been received, but as yet there are still late registrations to be considered. The winter term last year showed a registration of 701, late registrations and all. There has been an increase of 68 students for the same period of time, over the space of a year.


