

International Organization Proposed At Dumbarton Oaks



Economic and Social Council: Coordinator of International Agencies

"The only limit to our realization of tomorrow will be our doubts of today. Let us move forward with strong and acdoubts of today. Let us move forward with strong and active faith," said Franklin D. Roosevelt a few days before his tives of 44 nations July, 1944.

One of the most important proposals of the Dumbarton Oaks blueprint, which served as a skeletal plan of the general international organization, is the ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL SECURITY. This agency is to carry out the recommendations of the Assembly with respect to "international economic, social and other humanitarian problems and promote respect for human rights and human freedom," and even make recommendations with respect to such matters on its own initiative. UNITED NATIONS FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANIZATION

Sixteen nations have already accepted the proposals of the Interim Commission established by the 1943 Hot Springs Nations Conference on Food and Agriculture. As soon as four more nations accept the recommended constitution, the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO) of the United Nations will become an accomplished fact. The general objective of the FAO is to bring about great-

er efficiency in the production and distribution of food; to better the conditions of the rural people, to contribute there-by to an expanding world economy. The proposed constitution provides for affiliation with any general world organ-

A \$2,500:000 budget has been proposed for the first year Of this amount, the United States would be asked to provide \$625,000. For four years thereafter, a \$5,000,000 budget has been recommended.

The general structure somewhat parallels UNRRA. Howeven, it differs, in that UNRRA is a temporary body responsible for direct relief operations while the FAO will be a permanent organization, serving primarily as a fact-finding, educational, and consultative agency.

INTERNATIONAL LABOR ORGANIZATION

The International Laabor Organization as fixed in the Treaty of Versailles, consists of two organs: THE GENERAL CONFERENCE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF MEM-BER NATIONS and an INTERNATIONAL LABOR OFFICE controlled by the governing body. It is Tripartite in character—that is the delegates must be appointed by he head of the government: two must represent the state; one the leading employers association (in the United States the Chamber of Conmerce); and one must represent the principal worker's organization (AFL in the United States).

ILO has been invaluable because of its extensive fact-find-ing and recommendations to national governments made by convention drafts.

The conventions have recommended unemployment bene-flat for seamen, farmers, minimum age of young people in industrial jobs, initiated uniform statistical and other in-formation relative to emigration and immigration. Aside from making recommendations the international Labor or-ganization has published definitive studies on whole indus-tries (coal, textiles, merchant magine, social security). It has amassed a library of 500,000 books which former head of the ILO John G. Winnet called "best library on social and labor problems in the world."

The 26th Conference of the ILO was held in Philadelphia in April, 1944. At that time a Philadelphia Charter was drawn up. The core of the charter is the concept of world employment by expanding production. ILO believes that without long term and coordinated public works in all countries, maximum use of each nation's labor exchange by both employers and employees is necessary, otherwise there will be little prosperity.
