Response articles concerning works previously published in Kinesis are encouraged, and we also welcome Emailed submissions should be saved in Microsoft Word format (*.doc) and prepared for blind review. The author's name should not appear anywhere in the document except for on a cover sheet containing the author's contact information and institutional affiliation. Submissions mailed via post should include a CD-ROM or DVD-ROM with the submission saved in Microsoft Word format (*.doc) and prepared for blind review and three paper copies of the submission also prepared for blind review. Any submissions that have been published elsewhere or are under consideration for publication elsewhere will not be considered for publication in Kinesis.
