In an article written by the late President Roscoe Pulliam this significant statement was made: "Neglect of the public schools of the area during the past half century was certainly partly responsible for the serious-effects of the depression on Southern Illinois and for the resulting huge cost of relief and destitution in the region. The poverty of Southern Illinois is due quite as much to a lack of practical education and clear vision on the part of too many of our citizens as it is to lack of fertile soil and the unfortunate collapse of our basic industries of agriculture

Thus we see that not only the problems of SINU face Dr. Lay but the bigger and more complex economic and social problems of Southern Ulinois.
