At times, in our enthusiasm to look and plan for the future we tend to lose sight of what is taking place in Washington that will directly affect our post-war world.

One of the most reactionary and unfortunately successful attacks was made by the House Appropriations Committee against worthwhile agencies operating in the domestic field of education, housing and health.

Our legislators have suddenly become so "economy-minded" that \$180,000,000 of administration requests were turned down. They are:

Defense Housing: Private real estate interests again won out when an appropriation was refused even though there is a definite need for deeen thomes for war workers. The Committee felt if such a program were given impetus there would be the possibility of "public housing being overbuilt." Emergency Medical Care: One-third of the nations doctor are in the armed services. As a result he medical care of the country is below minimum. The Public Health Service was planning to persuade private practitioners to take up practice or to move in public health doctors. The request for \$1,000, however, was turned down because it was felt that perluaps federal, state and local agencies could best work out a satisfactory program.
