

ADVANCEMENT

One in ten people in Bartonville are below the growing poverty line and the poverty levels in Bartonville schools are doubling. With the amount of students in school under the poverty level increasing, the test scores are decreasing. In 2010 at Limestone Community High School, 51% of the students that attended Limestone meet or exceeded in Reading and Mathematics on their PSAE Test, but in 2011 only 47% of students meet or exceeded and in 2012 only 44% of students meet or exceeded.² In a three-year timeframe, students of Limestone Community High School dropped seven percentage points on their scores. As noted in the U.S. News Educational Scorecard, Limestone Community High School students raked 4.6 out of 100 points on the college readiness index and in Bartonville only twelve percent of residents twenty-five years old and over have obtained a bachelor's degree and only four percent have obtained a graduate or professional degree.³

The students of Bartonville are in need of educational empowerment and career guidance. One way that students could receive educational empowerment is though afterschool tutoring. In a controlled study on the effects of afterschool tutoring on students, students who received tutoring in math and reading substantially outperformed their initial test results and students who did not receive tutoring at all.11

PRESERVATION

With the turn of the 21st century, many of the original historic buildings in Bartonville of the Peoria State Hospital have been demolished. Currently, 1 of the 13 remaining buildings on the grounds of the Old Peoria State Hospital, the Bowen Building as noted in the figures, is scheduled to be razed.1

"Preservation is often the catalyst for community change. People who being that they have no interest in planning and zoning issues react emotionally to the threatened demolition of a childhood landmark."² With 90% of Bartonville's residents being born in the Peoria-area, it would be nostalgic for the community to encompass parts of its history.³ One way residents of Bartonville can find value in a new community center would be to use the original stones from the Bowen Building to tie the herritage of the community into a new building.

As noted above, depression effects one in ten adults in the United States however, in Bartonville depression effects over double the national average with one in four adults falling victim to depression.¹

The key findings in a 2010-2011 study on the Effectiveness of Community Engagement and Planning for Services to Address Depression found, "Incorporating community programs...can help improve people's quality of life and lower the risk of a life crisis."2

With the findings of the study on the Effectiveness of Community Engagement, Bartonville could serve as a catalyst to improve depression in the form of a community center. The community center could serve as one common location for residents to attend much needed services. The services provided could in turn strengthen the mental and physical health of Bartonville residents, open advancement opportunities, and give residents a sense of purpose in their lives.
