The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

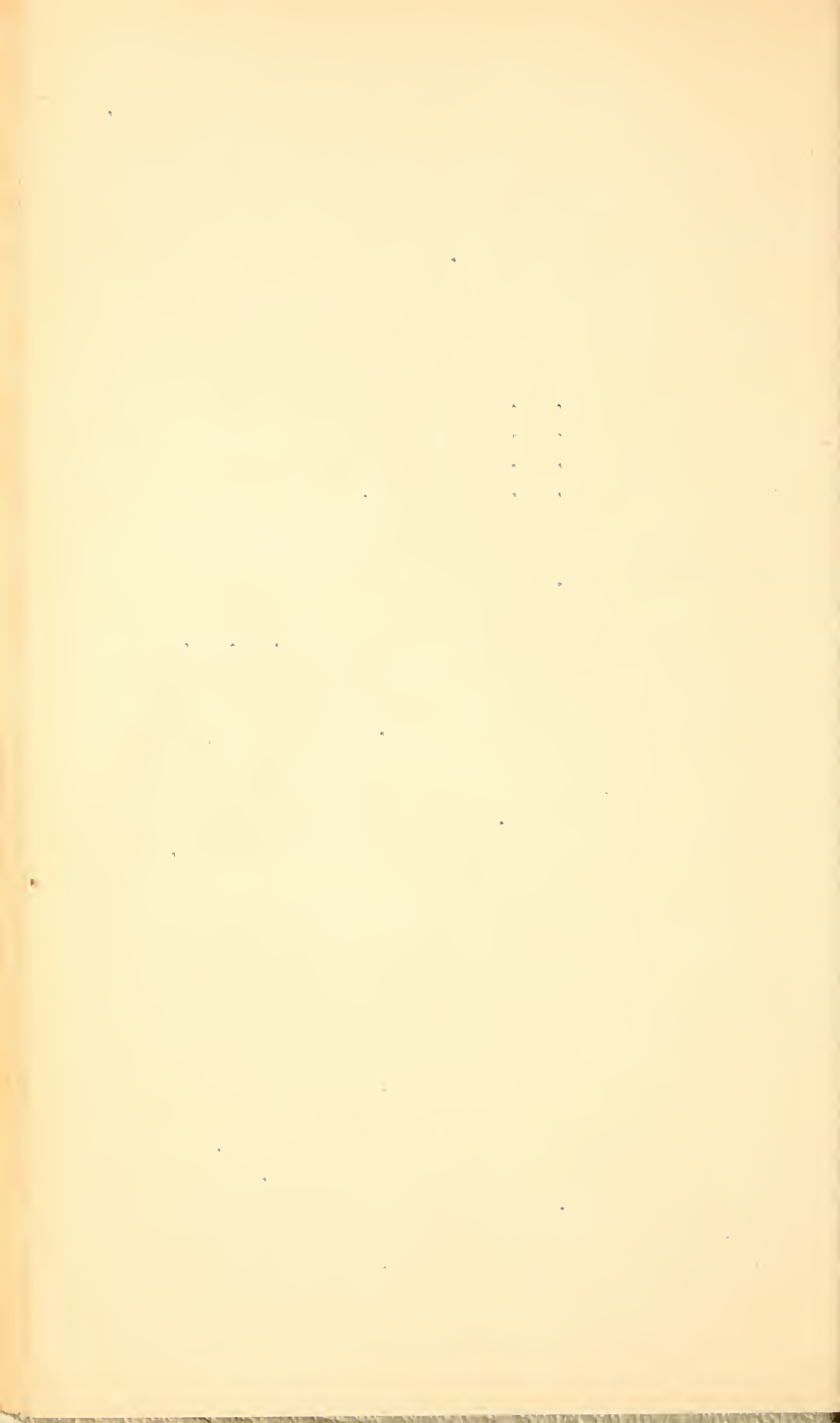
On motion, the Secretary and Mr. W. W. Williams, with the President, were appointed a Committee to arrange for the laying of the corner stone of the new building.
